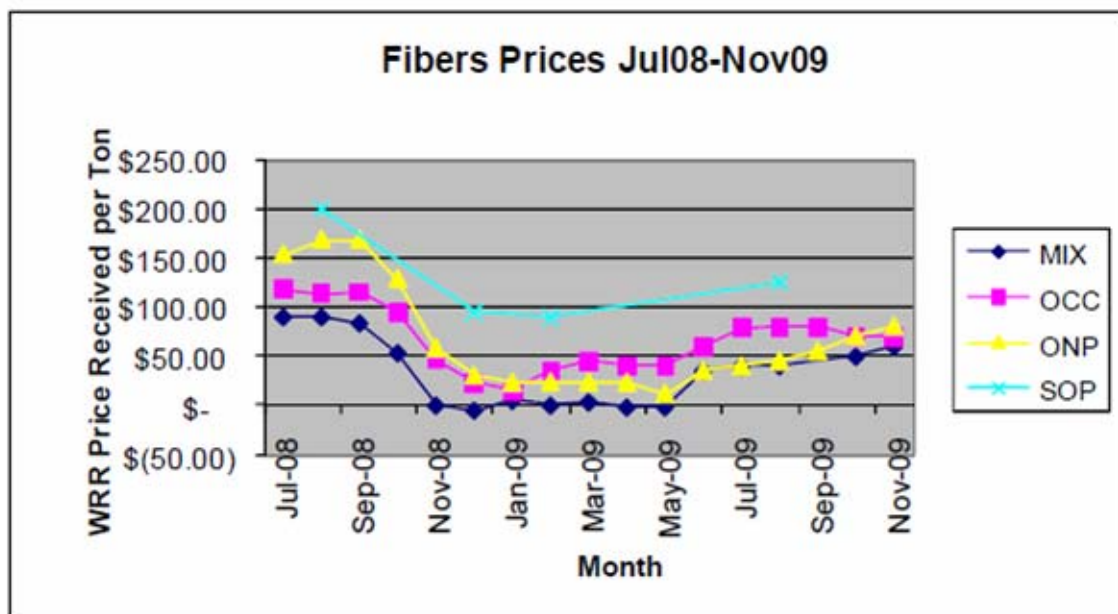

**COMPOST PROGRAM**

Separate yard waste collection will end, weather permitting, on Monday, December 21, 2009 and resume Monday, March 1, 2010. During the interim, yard waste will be picked up with regular household trash.

The Christmas Tree-Cycling collection will take place this season on the following 3 Mondays: December 28<sup>th</sup>, January 4<sup>th</sup> and January 11<sup>th</sup>. Trees will be collected to be used for wildlife habitat.

73 landscapers have signed up and been issued access fobs for 2009, and 2 have already signed up for 2010.
